The Board passed a Resolution to purchase 6 Voting Machines from Automatic Voting Machine Corp., to gether with two canvas strips to hold keys. See letter attached.

The Board obtained permission from Mr. Kirk, President of The County Commissioners, to rent the room at 103 S. Potomac St. Mr. Stouffer was to contact Mr. Roessner in regards to same, for temporary office for Board of Election Supervisors from Sept. 1, 1961 until the new annex is completed and Board of Election Supervisors have moved in.

The Board decided to close for the Hagerstown Fair in accordance with the closing of the offices of the Court House by the County Commissioners.
