Under new business, a letter was received from Mrs. Hilton C. Smith, RT#2 Boonsboro, Md. requesting information pertaining to voter registration. We discussed same and further checks will be made regarding their legal residence and will report at next meeting.

Mr. Harcelrode made motion to accept Mr. Dunham's resignation as Attorney to the Board, seconded by Mr. Kaylor.

A bill for professional service was received from Mr. Dunham, pertaining to the counting of the absentee ballots in the past November election. Same was tabled until a later date.

A request made by St. Maria Goretti High School to have someone from Election Board appear before the student body on Feb. 17th to give a talk covering Elections was discussed. Mr. Harcelrode will appear at 2:30 PM on the 17th. Also they want to use 2 large voting Machines on March 2nd, and they will take care of all expense covering same. Mr. Kaylor made motion to accept the above, Mr. Harcelrode, seconded same.

Mr. Harcelrode made motion that Washington County go on record that Election Bill not be submitted to this term of the legislature, due too large election Board turnover this June and in addition it would give all concerned parties greater opportunity to thoroughly digest such an extensive Bill, seconded by Mr. Kaylor.
