

April 14, 1964

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held at 3 P.M. on April 14th, at the New Court House Annex.

The following Members of the Board were present:

Mr. Donald E. Zombro
Mr. Charles G. Bikle

Due to the absence of Mr. Harclerode, Chairman, Mr. Zombro presided at the meeting.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were accepted as read.

Board agreed to have the 2 Assistant Machine Custodians work several nights assisting with the setting up of the voting Machines as a refresher course, also to work on Primary Election Day, May 19th. They will receive an hourly wage of \$2.00 per hour.

Letter was received from Mr. R. Samuel Dillon, Hancock, requesting list of registered Democrat Voters for this County. Board then gave us permission to hire girls to complete the list as required by Law. We will receive $\frac{1}{2}$ cent per name.

Mrs. A. L. Dayhoff, Indian Springs wants the voting machines moved from her property at once and we cannot use her place for the Primary Election, as we had planned. Board suggested that Bill would be prepared for \$15.00 that is the amount that was paid her for the use of her property for the last election. We must find a new Voting place at once. Mr. Zombro will contact Mr. Wilkinson of Indian Springs, Pres. of Ruitan Club, about a place to vote.

Mr. Kepler called and wants Board to discuss location of voting machines at Woodlandway School with Mr. Callas, Prin. Mr. Zombro will handle this matter and report back to me.

Reported to Board that the New Machine Covers were delivered to Huyetts School by Mr. Niner.

On April 24th, Order will be given to C. & P. Telephone Co., for installing 2 additional phones for May 19th.

On May 4th, letter will be sent to County Rds. Dept. giving moving instructions for the delivery of the Machines stored at Huyetts, for the Primary May 19th.

On May 11, Letter will be sent to Sgt. Divine of the Hagerstown Police Dept. requesting special parking privileges for the polls workers for the picking up of their supplies and Books, and also on Election Day, May 19th.

Representatives for the Addressograph Co, called ~~xxx~~ on Apr. 10 with information covering the setting up of a system of the registered voters of Washington County, I advised them to contact the 3 Board Members. By using the Machine now in use by the County, it would cost approximately \$4,500 for material and Cabinets.

Mr. Harclerode & Mr. Zombro discussed same and were in favor of including the above in the 1964-1965 Budget, but due to the absence of

Mr. Harclerode, matter was closed, as Mr. Bikle was opposed to same.

Mr. Zombro will contact Mr. Harclerode about a special meeting to O.K. the Budget and also the Ballot.

Meeting adjourned.
