Marty Lumm opened the floor for comments. Barry Jackson stated that any voter can go to any of the 11 vote centers to vote on Election Day. He explained the reasons for not using the following high schools:

- Smithsburg High School – cafeteria accessible by elevator and stairs; opted to use Smithsburg Middle Cafeteria;
- Technical High School – very close to South High opted to use Bester Elementary Gym.
- Barbara Ingram School – no large, ground level room available; opted to use Girls Inc.

Kaye Robucci told the Board that due to several of the gymnasium floors being redone over the summer – tarps will need to be used to protect the floors on Election Day. Those include: Boonsboro High School and North Hagerstown. Connie Mozingo voiced her concerns regarding tarps based on her experience at Bester.

Scheduling of Next Meeting:


