

April 9, 1969

The Board of Election Supervisors met at the Courthouse on April 9, 1969 at 3:30 P.M.

The following members were present:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Under old business, the Board tabled until the next meeting, the case of Ralph Leatherman, the Renners, and Ed Worden.

We received a check from the B.M.D Development Corp. in the amount of \$50.00 as part reimbursement on the slide covers that we ordered from Automatic Voting Machine Company. This check to be turned over to the County Commissioners.

Motion by Mr. McCauley and seconded by Mr. Long that the Board accept the application for the military absentee ballot that was sent to us by the Secretary of State. Motion carried. Letter will be sent to the Secretary of State advising him of this decision.

In answer to a letter from Attorney Lawrence B. Scally, Board advised that we tell him that we are now accepting registration for the American Party.

Mr. Kaylor read letters received from the Secretary of State and the Attorney General's office advising us to accept registrations with the American Party. However, they advised that the American Party can not have Judges of Elections or Registrars at this time.

Mr. Kaylor had received a request from the local Union to use the voting machines for their election. He advised the Union to put the request in writing to the Board. Since this written request has not been received, this will be tabled until the next meeting.

Board discussed those people who refused to sign change of address slips in the City Election. Board will check with our Attorney to see if we have authority to make them to their correct district without their signature.

Motion by Mr. McCauley and seconded by Mr. Long that we let the extra phones in. Motion carried.

The Board then discussed the Budget for 1969-70 as presented to them by Mrs. Waters and approved it. Copy of Budget to be sent to Accounting Department.
