The Board of Election Supervisors met at the Court House on Tuesday, June 4, 1974 at 2:00 P.M.

3. A letter written to Mr. Dull. concerning our moving to the Montgomery Ward Building, stating that the mezzanine would not be accessible to the public. Mr. Patterson will call Mr. Dull in regards to this matter.

Poll Workers school was discussed. The following dates were set-up.

Tuesday - August 20, 1974
Wednesday - August 28, 1974
Thursday - September 5, 1974

All schools will be held at the North Hagerstown High School.

Machine Custodians were discussed. The office is to contact Mr. Jessop and Mr. Thomas if they will be available if needed for setting - up voting machines.

The office will be going to North St. School for Voter Registration on Saturday, July 13, 1974 from 2:00 to 4:00 P.M. This was requested by Mr. Moten.

The Board decided we would not change addresses from petitions at this time. Poll workers will be instructed to get change of addresses on Election day.

Mr. Patterson told Board members that Voter Registration by mail is now expanding to many counties and Washington County may be included in the future.

The office is to contact the Walcott & Taylor Co. about Print-Out Binder Files. The Montgomery County Election Board is now using this type of system.
