Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Patterson made a motion we put the following in the minutes, seconded by Mr. Bartles:

The Board met on Saturday, February 21, 1976, with the District Workers, Delegates and Senators in regards to eliminating poll workers in some districts. The Board decided not to make any changes for the next two elections.

Poll workers were discussed.

Mr. Patterson will talk with the County Commissioners at 4:30 P.M. on Tuesday, March 30, 1976, regarding the removal of the telephone on the counter.

Mr. Bartles made a motion we allow \$1,000 in our budget for repairing forty voting machines. Seconded by Mr. Downey. Motion carried.

Mr. Patterson will show the slides that will be used at Poll Workers School at the Election Board office on Friday, April 2, 1976, at 7:30 P.M.

Purchasing voters list will continue to be conducted in the same manner.

Mr. Patterson will meet with Mayor Paddock to discuss using City Hall for District 22-1 voting place.

The budget was approved by the Board and will be submitted to the County Commissioners.

April 7, 1976, is the date to have the ballot ready for public display and give bids to printers. The Board will meet on that date.
