Two Printing Companies have requested to bid on the printing for the Elections. After a lengthy discussion on this matter, Mr. Patterson will call Mr. Haynes of Hagerstown Bookbinding and Printing Co. to talk with him about this matter.

The office reported the machine custodians have finished repairing about 1/3 of the voting machines.

The Ryder Truck Co. will be delivering and returning the voting machines for the Primary Election. We will be renting two trucks from this company and hiring eight men from the County Roads Dept. to do this work.

Mr. Patterson will talk with Jean Calhoun about making the Tally Boards for the Election.

Mr. Long made a motion we print the names of the Candidates on the Specimen Ballot that will be displayed on the window for five days. Jean Calhoun will be doing this printing. Seconded by Mr. Spigler.

Mr. Long made a motion we pay Row's Bingo \$50.00 for using the building for Election Day. Mr. Zombro seconded the motion.

The Custodians will be setting up an extra voting machine for each Delegate District. A voting machine will be on display in the Court House.

The candidates for the School Board will be announced in the Newspaper. The Election Board office will notify the candidates who do not qualify for office.

Registration at Smithsburg was tabled until a later date.
