A special meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held at the office 103 So. Potomac St., Tuesday Morning at 10:30 A.M.

Mr. Kepler, from the Board of Education called by phone and wanted to call to thier attention the "No Smoking" condition that he wish to have in all Schools, also that the School custodians expected to be paid for over time as had previously been done, and that all phones would be made available for our use on Election Day. He suggested that the 2 front rooms on 1st Floor be used for voting instead of the auditorium, at Boonsboro Junior High School.

It was decided to have a training School for all Judges, to be held on Oct. 23 & 24 at Ft. Dale Elementary School at 7:30 P.M. Also to send letter of instructions to all judges.

Speciman Ballot was OK'd with the exception that the dividing lines were to^{be}/removed between the candidates names were more than 1 person were running for the same office, such as House of Delegates, County Commissioners and Judges of The Orphans Court, etc.

The Board discussed the salary of our prior Attorney, Richard Sweeney, having been continued on pay-roll while he was too ill to perform his duties, and we had to have legal advice from our temporary Attorney, Lynn Meyers from Apr. 1st to present time for which he never received any compensation. The Board will each separately discuss the above with the County Commissioners and see if something can be worked out whereby Mr. Meyers can be compensated for his legal advice during this period.
