The Board of Election Supervisors yesterday appointed Mrs. Virginis S. Clopper as Clerk to the Board and as the Democratic permanent registrar of voters to succeed Charles S. G. Hartle.

Mrs. Clopper had the unanimous recommendation of the Democratic Central Committee.

Her appointment marks the first time in the political history of the county that a member of the fair sex will serve as clerk to the Election Board.

Associated with her as the Republican registrar will be Mrs. Alsetta U. Schlotterbeck, who was named to the post by Governor Lane on recommendation of the Republican Central Committee. She succeeds William C. Ardinger, Williamsport.

The Supervisors yesterday also reappointed Calvert K. Hartle as attorney to the Board and reorganized by reelecting J. Richard Rauth, president and Luther W. Broom, secretary. William McP. Miller is the other member of the Board.
