They met Monday, June 3rd, at office of the Board of Election Supervisors , 103 So. Potomac St., at 12 noon and organized as follows:

No action was taken by the Board for a new Attorney at this time.

Mr. Charles G. Bikle appointed Mrs. Dorothy M. Waters as Republican Registrar for 2 years as of June 1, 1963.

Minutes of previous meetings held during May, 1963 were read to acquaint new Board of old business.

I explained work being done at present time by Machine Custodians and the conditions under which the Machines are stored.

Reported to Board as this was an off Election year we were checking each district within City with new City Directory and telephone book and had sent 925 Transfers since Feb. 2nd, and 185 names had been removed from our records of persons who moved from this County.

Mr. Zombro made a motion that before this Board declares an Election Official that each Absentee Ballot must be validated for Voters qualification. Mr. Harcelrode seconded motion and it was passed unanimously.

Board left the decision of placing voting machine in part of permanent Counter at the discretion of the Architect and present Registrar.

Board requested copy of minutes be sent to each Member.

Board requested a copy of 1962 Democrat Poll Workers be given to each Democrat Member, and the Republican Member requested of his party.

Mr. Harclerode requested Press be given information regarding organization of New Board.
