

July 3, 1968

The Board of Election Supervisors held its regular June meeting at the office on July 3 at 3 P.M.

The following members were present:

The minutes were read and approved.

Under old business Mr. Long reported that he and Mr. McCauley had been out looking for a voting place for Dist. 17-1. They checked at the Westinghouse Supply and the Unemployment Office. The Westinghouse Supply Co. isn't suitable and Mr. Ebersole at the Unemployment Office is going to check to see if we can use this building and he will advise us.

We received a sample of a card saying "Leave voting printers down" from the Automatic Company at a cost of 10¢ each. After discussion Mr. McCauley made a motion that we order 150 of these from Automatic, seconded by Mr. Long and motion carried.

Board discussed the registration of Mrs. Joan Dills. After seeing a letter from her probation officer the Board decided to let her register.

The Board decided to check with Mr. Parsley about the extra girls filling out Personnell sheets. This will be tabled until the next meeting.

We discussed ordering Poll Books. Rudy & Spong have quoted \$168.13 for 500 of these. Board decided to get a price from Hagerstown Bookbinding also.

We discussed the binders that will have to be split. We have already divided Dist. 25-3 and there are more that will probably have to be divided.

Board voted to transfer Franklin J. Schaller and Edgar M. Cline to their proper districts, although they would not sign a transfer blank and to notify them of their new voting place.

.Mr. Kaylor read a letter from the Williamsport Clubs stating that they would like for us to come to Williamsport to register. Mr. Kaylor and Mr. Long will draft a letter to answer this.

Board shall determine the extra help we will need. They suggested that we use 4 girls on July 13.

He said he hope that the Board would re-consider and go out to the County towns for registration or give him an answer as to why we are not going out to the county towns to register.
