BOARD OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS
FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY

The Board of Election Supervisors held a special meeting on Monday, September 17, 1990 at 9:30 A. M. to finalize the Primary Election.

The Board members signed the certified copies of the result sheets that had been certified at the official tally completed on Thursday, September 13, 1990.

The absentee ballots were counted on Thursday, September 13, 1990 at 1:30 P. M. We used the new OPTECH II optical scanner for counting these. There were six ballots rejected because of having no one marked and three ballots that the Board members had to go over the voter's mark with the special pencil. Everyone was impressed with the operation of the new method to count absentee ballots. We had the press and candidates watching, as the outcome of the Delegate District 2C Republican race was determined by the absentee ballot count.

The Board members also signed invoices from the Primary election.

Dottie advised the Board that we have had a request from the League of Women Voters to use a voting machine at the Valley Mall on Friday September 21 and Saturday September 22 for their Voter Registration Campaign. Motion by Walter Bell and seconded by Richard Coss that they use one of our machines for this purpose. Dottie will make the arrangements to have the machine moved to the mall. Motion carried.

Our next regular Board meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 16, 1990 at 1:30 P. M. This meeting has been changed from the second Tuesday, as October 9 is the deadline for voter registration.

Motion by Richard Coss and seconded by Walter Bell that the meeting be ajourned at 10:30 A. M. Motion carried.
