The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on May 5th, a week earlier at 6:30 P.M. at New Court House Annex.

The following members of the Board were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

The First Order of business was the approving of the Speciman Ballot for the newspaper. Approved after changes and corrections were made.

Motion made by Mr. Harclerode to set up permanent file for each Election District, consisting of Poll-Workers, District Leaders, Voting Machine numbers, total registration, etc., Cost not to exceed \$50.00, seconded by Mr. Zombro.

Regarding request of News representatives to report returns from each precinct, Mr. Harclerode made motion that they must comply with Election Laws as set forth in Article 33 section 103 B of the Election Laws of Maryland, and must have proper Certificate showing sufficient evidence of the right of such challenger & watcher to be present in the polling room. Press Card is not sufficient. Motion carried.

Mr. Zombro made motion that all Chief Judges must be called for a special meeting before the Primary Election, giving definite instructions pertaining to the above. Motion passed.

Board authorized additional help for Election night and Canvass Day.
