

January 28, 1964

The regular meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was postponed until January 28th, due to a special meeting called of all Election Officials of the State of Maryland, that was held on Jan. 21st and 22nd, at which time Clerks and Board Members attended.

The following Members of the Board were present:

Read minutes of the previous meeting and they were approved as read.

Bills for expense of Board Members attending meeting were approved and will be sent to County Commissioners for payment.

Under old business was the purchasing of additional voting machine covers. Quotations and samples were received from Automatic Voting Machine Co., and Niner Awning Co., Mr. Zombro made a motion that order be given to Niner Awning Co., for 24 Covers as per sample at \$4.50 each. Motion passed.

Board will let the Clerks in Office make the decision regarding extra phones for Primary Election. Two additional telephones will be installed at that time.

Budget was discussed. Conference table suggested by the County Commissioners will be acceptable to the Board.

1964 Election Dates prepared by our Attorney was OK'd by the Board subject to correction.

Reported on meeting at Rockville, a summary of the minutes taken at meeting had previously been given to Board. Board went on record as approving decisions reached at Rockville meeting and requested our Legislatores be advised. A letter will be sent to each as follows:

"It is the opinion that the present Wheatley Bill # 584 is unacceptable and the changes recommended by the Committee that met in Rockville should be incorporated", Also if the Minutes of the meeting arrive in time they should be enclosed.

Board will compensate Regular Clerks in Office for their overtime during the preparation and handling of necessary forms prior to Primary Election.

Donald E. Zombro made a motion that 2 girls, 1 of each political party be hired to assist with extra work and to receive \$1.25 per hour, for a period not to exceed 10 working days, seconded and motion passed unanimously. Mr. Bikle to appoint the Republican girl and Mr. Harclerode and Mr. Zombro to appoint the Democrat girl.

We have been given authority by Board to purchase all necessary supplies for Primary Election.

Board agreed that the Voting Places remain the same for the Primary Election.
