The Board of Election Supervisors held its meeting at the office on April 14, 1970 at 1:15 P.M.

The following members were present:

The minutes on the previous meeting were read and approved.

✓ It was announced to the Board the County Commissioners have decided the Data Processing Cards of Registered Voters are not available for purchase. The list of registered voters names are available at $\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per name with total payment in advance.

The office has received the opinion from the Attorney General's Office about the voters requesting their names to be removed from the books and re-registering at a later date with another party. These persons must sign a statement under oath that they are not using this cancellation as a vehicle for bringing about a party affiliation.

The office received a letter from Mack Truck requesting us to set up registration at their plant. The board discussed this matter. Mr. Patterson made a motion we go to Mack Truck for registration. Seconded by Mr. McCauley. Mr. Patterson will call Mr. Mackrell and set up all details. Mr. Long voted against this motion.

The next meeting of the Maryland Association of Election Officials will be held at the Holiday Inn in Annapolis on May 15th - May 16th 1970. It was briefly discussed and plans will be made at a later date.

The Board approved the setting-up of the files for the candidates as presented by the clerks.

The budget was accepted by the Board with one exception. The Board approved an increase of \$200.00 per year for the attorney of the Board, Mr. Padula.
