SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS  
FOR

The Board of Election Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, January 12, 1981, at 2 P.M. at the Board office. Chairman Bast called the meeting to order.

Motion by Virgil Banzhoff and seconded by Charles Downey that we dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting held on December 9, 1980, and that the minutes be approved as submitted.

Under communications, Chairman Bast read a letter from the town of Williamsport requesting the use of two voting machines for their town election to be held on March 2, 1981. Motion by Mr. Downey and seconded by Mr. Banzhoff that the town be granted the use of the machines and that the town be responsible for all expenses pertaining to the moving and use of the machines. Motion passed.

Chairman Bast presented the pre-filed election related bills that we have received from the State Board of Elections.

Under old business the Board discussed the need for the new filing system. Chairman Bast advised the Board that the County Commissioners are waiting to see if the State will assume the expenses of the county Election Boards. The Board will discuss this more at our next meeting.

The Board also discussed their request to the County Commissioners for additional funds for Temporary Wages which the Commissioners have deferred action on at this time. Dottie advised the Board that we are presently \$454.00 in the red. The Board will discuss the possibility of transferring funds from another line item in our present budget.

The Board discussed the Maryland Association Meeting to be held at Hunt Valley. Dottie advised the Board that the four seminars have been set up so that each person will be able to attend all of the seminars. The three Board members and Dottie and Daris will be going to this meeting.

Under new business Dottie advised the Board that the City Election Board has not been appointed yet and that the office staff is busy preparing for the City Primary to be held on January 27, 1981.

There being no other new business Mr. Downey moved that the meeting be adjourned. Seconded by Mr. Banzhoff and motion carried. The next meeting will be held on February 10, 1981.
