Mrs Virginia Clopper was appointed Democratic Permanent Register by Gov. Theodore McKeldin and qualified by swearing in before the Clerk of the Court.

Eckis To Head Election Board

Samuel K. Eckis, Williamsport, is expected to be elected president of the incoming Board of Election Supervisors when the three new members meet Monday afternoon to organize.

Eckis, a Republican, served as a supervisor some years ago. Other members of the Board to take office Monday are Joseph Rinehart, Republican, and John Latimer, Jr., Democrat.

The three will succeed J. Richard Rauth, Wm. McPherson Miller and Vincent E. Sprecher.

Paul Ottinger is slated to be named attorney to the new Board, succeeding Aubrey Kemp.

Mrs. Alsetta Myers will be appointed clerk and Republican register while Mrs. Virginia S. Clopper has been appointed the Democrat register.
