The Board of Election Supervisors met on Tuesday, February 25, 1975 at 2:30 P.M. in the Election Board office.

Registration in High Schools was discussed. Mr. Spigler made a motion we go to all the schools in April for registration. Mr. Patterson seconded the motion. Mr. Long opposed this motion. The office will set-up the schedule.

The budget was discussed and approved. Mr. Long made a motion we accept the budget. Mr. Spigler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Additional space is needed to store our voting machines. The board suggested that additional space be added to the present building that is now being used at the County Roads Dept. Mr. Patterson has talked with Mr. Metz of Civil Defense Dept. and there is a possibility we may be able to use the adjoining building at the Roads Dept. to store some of the machines. Mr. Patterson will have an answer in the near future.

Plans for moving our office to the Montgomery Ward building was briefly discussed.

Mr. Poole is composing two letters for the office.

One will be to the County Commissioners for the city to make available the agreement made between the city and county when they merged in 1951. If this agreement can not be made available, we are asking for a new contract be made between the city and county.

A letter also to the City Attorney informing the city if they are going to re-district the city it must be done in 1975. Also legal information in regards to changing boundary lines in order for the city to re-district.

Mr. Spigler made a motion to adjourn.
