Poll Workers School was discussed and letters will be sent out to each worker announcing the dates and advising them to attend. Poll workers must be appointed by June 16, 1970.

It was announced to the Board a thank-you note has been sent to Mrs. Bowman for the picture of the Hager House.

The Board was advised there are still eight more persons whose letters were returned while sub-dividing Halfway. Mr. Long made a motion we remove these persons names from the files. Seconded by Mr. Patterson. Motion carried.

The office has received a letter from Mr. Kepler informing us we will be able to use the Boonsboro and Smithsburg schools for registration, and also the North Hag. High school for the Poll workers school.

The voting place at Smithsburg has been changed to Smithsburg Elementary School.

The office has received a letter from the State Administrative Office advising us we can not accept any certificates of candidacy for any office by the American Party until they are certified to us by their office.

The office also was advised by Mr. Morris's office we shall register residents of federal enclaves that are located within our county.

Temporary Certificate of Registration was briefly discussed. Mr. Padula will give us an opinion on this.
