The Board met at the Election Board Office on Friday, Oct. 23, 1970 at 11:00 a.m. All three members were present.

The Board proof-read the Ballot that will appear in the newspaper on October 24, 1970.

The Tally Boards were discussed. It was decided we use four unofficial boards:

- (2) 8 thru 15 - Candidate's Name
- (3) 16 thru 25 - Candidate's Name
- (4) Amendments

It was also decided we use 3 official boards:

- (1) 1 thru 11 - Candidate's Name
- (2) 12 thru 26 - Candidate's Name
- (3) Amendments

The Board voted to have the same Change of Voting Place ads put in the Newspaper as was in for the Primary Election, along with the change for the Hospital Grounds to the Antietam Professional Center - 138 E. Antietam St. (17-1). This will appear in the newspaper on October 31st, and November 2nd.

Mrs. Eleanor Kendall will work the switch-board on Election Day.

The Board will meet next Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. to approve the Absentee Ballot Applications.
