Richard Long and William Dorsey appeared before the Board to discuss salaries in setting up and repairing voting machines.

Mr. Bartles moved we allow \$1,000 in our budget for machine custodians repairing 40 voting machines.

The budget was discussed including:

1. Permanent and Temporary Salaries
2. Eliminating Poll Workers
3. Moving Voting Machines
4. Capital Outlay

A letter is to be sent to Mr. Martin Snook, President of County Commissioners, and a copy to Mr. Barry Teach, County Administrator, asking them to damp-proof the outside walls of the building at the Roads Department where our voting machines are stored. We are submitting in our budget \$500, coded 442-000, for this job.

House Bill #956 was discussed. Mr. Downey will compose a letter to be sent to the Washington County Delegation and Senators opposing the State Assumption of Costs for Election Boards.
