

July 27, 1966

Meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on Wednesday July 27, at 5 P.M. in their office in the Court House Annex.

The following Members were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Mr. Eisentrout, of the data Processing Dept. appeared before the Board and discussed progress of making voters lists and explained ways of printing same. Motion was made to order 3,000 of the Triplicate paper for making voters Lists.

Mr. McCauley made motion to have a training school for all Chief Judges and New Judges, 2 nights, during the week of Aug. 29 to be held at Penn. Ave. North High School, seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Motion carried.

It is the decision of this Board to follow the opinion of the States Attorney of this County covering the Corrupt Practice Law, such as all Campaign literature etc. must be shown to read by authority of Candidate or by his Treasurer or Political Agent or if published or distributed by an organization the name of all officers of the organization must be attached or included on the literature and must state by the authority of blank Treasurer or Political Agent. Mr. McCauley made the above motion and was seconded by Mr. Harclerode. Motion carried.

Upholding a previous decision relating to "Nick Names" of candidates they made a motion that Elwood Tingle's name must appear as such on Ballot.

The Board Certified the Certificates of the Candidates that have filed for office and to the best of their knowledge and belief they appear to be correct.

Mr. McCauley made Motion that we would send 2 Registrars to the Fairground during Fair week, monday thru Saturday from 5 PM to 10 PM, Seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Motion carried. Mr. Harclerode will see that the sign, table & chairs are delivered there.

Board requested that Machine Custodians & Printer prepare Sample Ballot and then the Board will check same.

Board authorized Order for Absentee Ballots be given to Rudy & Spong. This will include Democrat, Republican for each Senatorial Sub Districts and also a Decline ballot.

Motion to ratify 5 Members of each Central Committee to be voted on at this election, Motion unanimously carried.

All Election Material will be headed as Primary & Special Election, because of the question on the Referendum being on the ballot this time.
