

November 9, 1965.

The regular meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on November 9, 1965 at 2 P.M. in the Court House Annex.

The following Members were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Forms submitted by Mr. Fraots of Moore Business Forms Inc., were discussed and motion was made by Mr. McCauley to place order for 5,000 each of Voter Registration & Change of Registration Forms, to be in Duplicate and in different colors. Seconded by Mr. Kaylor, motion passed unanimously.

Copies of letters that were sent to Mr. Robert Benner and Mrs Helen Musselman was read by Mr. Harclerode, President and names of both were removed from our files according to the Election Laws.

Mr. McCauley made motion to order 1- Automatic Voting Machine of the "Printomatic" type. Seconded by Mr. Kaylor.

Letter from Maryland Assoc. of Election Officials was read, stating that meeting will be held in January at which time they will take up the changes to Election Laws pertaining to the Primary that will be brought up during the 1965 Legislature.

Order for New Machine Covers was tabled until a later date.

Election Board will go in a body to the Roads Department to inspect the new building which contains the County Voting Machines., on Nov. 16th at 1:30 P.M. Board Members requested that they be remanded on monday of the time.

Reported 2,151 voters had been taken off in County district who had not voted in the past 5 years.

Under old business Mr. Harclerode suggested he would personally contact Mr. Merlin Snyder, Clerk of Circuit Court regarding Law on Sec. # 43C- names changed by Marriage and report at next meeting.

Motion made by Mr. McCauley to adjourn meeting, seconded by Mr. Kaylor.
