It was announced to the board the Poll workers letters are ready to be mailed to them announcing the dates of the school.

The Poll workers school was discussed. Instructions for the chief judges are to be given to them at the school and discussed at that time. One machine custodian and one sub. custodian are to be present each night of school. The new temporary certificate of registration was discussed and explained to the board. Mr. Padula authorized the use of the new form.

The voting place at Beaver Creek was changed to the Mt. Lena School.

Mr. McCauley read the budget report from the County Commissioners. Mr. Padula did not receive the \$200.00 raise the board requested. The Poll Workers received a \$5.00 increase.

Mr. McCauley made a motion we go to the Venice on August 5, 1970 from 7:00 to 10:00 P.M. for registration. Mr. Patterson seconded the motion. Mr. Padula read from the law book it is unlawful to vote or have registration in any building serving alcoholic beverages. Mr. McCauley will advise the persons requesting this registration of this.

The Primary Ballot was briefly discussed.

Mr. Patterson made a motion we adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Long.
