New Election bills were discussed and decisions were made if the members were for or against these bills.

Board Members and Clerks will be attending a meeting in Annapolis on Wednesday, January 29, 1975 at 11:00 A.M. to discuss House Bill # 63, to extend Registration by-mail to all Counties not presently under this system. Our Board has been asked to give their position on this bill at the meeting. We are in favor of the bill, subject to some questions.

Mr. Spigler made a motion our attorney meet with the city attorney and discuss and get legal information in regards to changing the boundary lines in order for the city to re-district. Opinion in writing.

Mr. Patterson will talk with Mr. Oswald about the agreement made between the City and County to combine their Voter Registration. This agreement was made in 1951.

More space is needed to store the voting machines. The Board decided adding to the existing building at the County Roads Dept. where most of the machines are stored. Mr. Spigler will check to see how much additional space is needed and will present this information to the County Commissioners in the near future.
