The regular monthly meeting was held by the Board of Election Supervisors on June 11th, at 3 P.M. at the office at 103 So. Potomac St.

The following members of the Board were present:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Mr. Zombro made a motion that Mr. John M. Colton, be retained as Attorney to the Board, seconded by Mr. Bikle and motion was passed unanimously. Board requested letter be sent him to notify him of same.

Invoice of the custodians were presented to Board for their O.K.. Moved that invoice be O.K.'d by Mr. Zombro, Mr. Harclerode seconded same, motion passed unanimously.

The Board requested that Custodians notify them when and where they will be working on Machines as they would like to observe same for their own personal information. Custodians will be attending school on June 16th at Jamestown, N.Y. and they are requested to report to Board on July 9th, at the next regular meeting pertaining to their schooling.

I reported to Board that 988 Transfer's had been mailed, and 220 persons had been removed of persons who had moved from County. Four Districts are left to do yet. Also informed Board that a daily or weekly report is kept of the Registered Voters in Washington County.

Reported to Board that we had contacted G. Merlin Snyder Clerk of the Circuit Court, regarding List of persons convicted in Circuit Court of Felonies. Only those over 21 years of age. This will be given to us after each term of Court. Due to change of personnel in his office no report had been received from them recently. Also he stated that he had never given us a report on females over 21 who had obtained marriage license. He suggested that when we moved to our new location, perhaps that we could check records and take off the ones that were from Wash. County.

There being no further business, Motion was made by Mr. Zombro to adjourn meeting, Motion was seconded by Mr. Bikle.
