Due to the appointment of Gov. Tawes of Brewer L. Stouffer to another position only the following members were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting of March 4th, was approved as read.

Mr. McCauley, Chairman, made motion to appoint Mr. John M. Colton, 138 W. Washington St., as Attorney to the Board and Mr. Hellane seconded same. I was instructed to send letter to the Clerk to the County Commissioners requesting that he be put on the pay-roll as of March 19th. Also to send letter of notification to Mr. Colton.

Mr. McCauley, Chairman of the Board also made another motion to appoint Mr. James R Pryor, R#3, Hagerstown, Md as the Democrat Machine Custodian, it was seconded by Mr. Hellane, and he was unanimously recommended by the Democrat State Central Committee as per Mr. Delphy, Chairman. Notify Mr. Pryor of the appointment and request letter of acceptance from him.
