Meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on March 3rd, at 3 P.M. a week earlier at the request of Mr. Bikle, who will be out of town on March 10th, 1964.

The following members of the Board were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Mr. Bikle made motion that Board would decide that no special County Registration would be made before the Presidential Primary, but special night openings would be held at office, seconded by Mr. Harclerode.

Board requested letter be sent to Machine Custodians asking them to notify Board if they are ever requested by any other person to set up voting Machines.

Instructions to Chief Judges were approved by Board and copies will be mimeographed up.

Reported to Board that if dates for filing isnt changed, Candidates Nominated should be received from Secretary of State not later than March 19th. At which time Board must meet to set up Ballot for printing.

Regarding Soldier Absentee Ballots:

Mr. Harclerode, Chairman made a motion that Office Clerks would handle Soldier Absentee Ballots without the approval of the Board, unless they felt there was reasonable doubt of the validity of application, Mr. Bikle seconded same.

Regarding Civilian Absentee Ballots:

Mr. Harclerode, Chairman, made motion that Office Clerks would handle Civilian Absentee Ballots same as above and if there were any questionable applications, to notify Board for final disposition of same, seconded by Mr. Bikle.

Applications for absentee Ballots may be partially completed before sending.

Letter to Sgt. Divine of the Hagerstown Police Dept. was sent on March 4th, requesting special parking on nights we will be open for special registration.
