The Board of Election Supervisors met at the office on October 12, 1971 at 2:00 P.M.

The following members were present:

Voting places were discussed. We will be using the Conoc., Keedysville, and Chewsville Schools. The office will call the Fairplay Fire Hall about using the hall for voting. Mr. Patterson will check the Colonial Harwood Flooring Co. about using their building for voting, Mr. Spigler will contact City Hall for same reason.

Registration in the High Schools was tabled until a later date.

The Board decided to go to the Hagerstown Junior College for Voter Registration. Time and date to be announced in the future.

The Street Directory is finished and a copy has been sent to the State Office. A motion was made by Mr. Long and seconded by Mr. Spigler to sell the Directory for \$2.00 per copy.

Small maps are now available in our office, free, if desired, larger maps can be purchased from the Map Dept. in the Court House.

The Board voted to purchase a Simplex Time Stamp for the office costing about \$215.00. Mr. Patterson will place the order.

The office has received a notice from the Co. Comm. announcing the Co. Travel was increased to 10¢ per mile on July 1, 1971.

The Board has requested a letter from Mr. Padula to send to persons who registered while in service to find out if they are still in service, if not to show cause why their names should not be removed from the books for not voting within five years.

A check from the Hancock Mayor and Council for the amount of \$81.38 will be turned over to the Co. Comm.

Mr. Patterson announced the Maryland National Banks located in the South End Shopping Center and the Long Meadow Shopping ^{Center} have invited us to their banks for Voter Registration.

Mr. Spigler made a motion we adjourn. Mr. Long seconded the motion.
