BOARD OF ELECTION SUPERVISORS

FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY

The Board of Election Supervisors held a special meeting on Tuesday, November 9, 1982, at the Board office. President Bast called the meeting to order at 10 A. M. He advised that this is a special meeting called to finalize the Election results and only those matters needing immediate attention will be addressed.

The Election returns were certified and the bills were signed.

MINUTES:

Charles Downey moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held on October 14, 1982, seconded by Virgil Banzhoff. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE:

President Bast read a memo from Barry Teach requesting any suggestions for new legislation. Following discussion by the Board Mr. Banzhoff moved that the Board members' salaries be increased to \$1,500 per year. Seconded by Mr. Downey and motion carried. They will also recommend an increase in salary for the Poll Workers. They decided to request \$55.00 per day for the Chief Judges and \$45.00 per day for the Judges.

The annual meeting of the Maryland Association of Election Officials to be held at Hunt Valley on January 9-11, 1983 was discussed. The three Board members and Dottie and Daris will be attending.

OLD BUSINESS:

Dottie advised the Board that she had checked with City Hall and we will not be charged for the Custodians opening the Building for the Elections.

NEW BUSINESS:

We will write a thank you note to the Teamster's Union Hall for use of their facilities for voting.

The Board discussed the possibility of a recount. President Bast outlined the procedure to be taken if a recount is requested by Ralph DeVore, candidate for the Board of Education. Mr. DeVore lost the election by seven votes. The deadline for him to petition for recount will be 11 A.M. on Friday, November 12, 1982.
