

July 20, 1962

A meeting was held by the Board of Election Supervisors at the office at 103 So. Potomac St., July 20th, 1962 at 10 A.M.

The following members of the Board were present:

Mr. R. A. McCauley, Pres.
Mr. Brewer L. Stouffer
Mr. J. G. Hellane

Mr. Stouffer said that he had 2 points to bring up:

1st- The Democrat Central Committee wants a registration List, and had no money to buy.

2nd- The Fire Marshall, made a report regarding this being a fire trap, and he would like to make a motion to give each party a list and we could have the use of it in case of an emergency.

Mr. Stouffer then rephrased his motion to read:

That Registration List of Voters be loaned to Democrat Central Committee for making a card file and the same List be offered to Republican Central Committee for the same purpose, with a proviso that List be returned to Board of Election Supervisors Office and that both Committees be requested not to offer said list for sale; Seconded by Mr. McCauley, Mr. Hellane, refused to vote at this time.

No Lists to be given out until they talk to both Central Committees.

Mr. McCauley, said he had several requests to sit in Halfway, to register, and Geo. Fisher will let us have his building free, providing we pay for the lights, and we will furnish table & chairs. It was decided that we would sit there to register on Aug. 21st, from 5 Pm to 9 P.M. next to Fisher's Pharmacy, on Virginia Ave. Halfway, Md.

Mr. McCauley requested that a letter be written to Mrs. Anna Martin, Church of God, Indian Springs, Md. thanking her for the use of the building during the Primary and if it would be available for the General Election, Nov. 6th, 1962 and for her to advise us immediately.

Our lawyer advised us that according to the law we would be unable to use the American Legion Hall in Boonsboro for the General Election, and we made plans to meet with Mr. Smith & Mr. Herr to locate another voting place, also the Board could use Pangborn School, if they would all agree to sign statement to the effect no other place was available in the same district .

Meeting adjourned.
