Mr. Patterson announced the City voting machines have been moved to the Mont. Ward building. The machine custodians are now working on the voting machines.

Registration by mail has been good. We have registered 221 by this date.

Final plans were made for the Ocean City meeting to be held on Oct. 26, - 28, 1975.

Mr. Patterson suggested the first of the year we advertise voter registration by mail in the newspaper and install a phone-mate system.

Mr. Patterson read a letter from Ed. Nichols Assoc. We are to ask Mr. Kinzer of Data Processing Dept. to get us an appointment with the Univac factory man to talk with us in regards to just what this equipment can do for our office.

The three resolutions were discussed. The office is to have ready for discussion for the November meeting the number of voting machines and workers in each district.

The Election Board office will be moving to the Mont. Ward building the first of the year. We have ordered from Longs Business Co. the following equipment needed for moving:

- 1 - metal table for master files
- 1 - cabinet for storing binders

Mr. Bartles made a motion we buy one used desk for \$50.00 from Longs Business Co. This desk will need painting.

The office received a reminder from the State Office we must file with them any change in the cost of voters list.

The AVM factory technician will be here on Wednesday, September 17, 1975 to check-out six voting machines.
