

Dec. 8, 1970

The Board met at the Election Board Office on Tuesday, Dec. 8, 1970 at 2:00 P.M.

The following members were present:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The Board examined and with a few corrections approved the letter to be sent to the poll workers in district 17-1.

Mr. Patterson will call a meeting when he hears from Mr. Wakenight in regards to the printing of the new voters cards.

The office will start typing the new voters cards Jan. 4, 1971. We will use four girls to start the job and see how it works out.

It was announced to the Board we have pulled 700 persons from the records who have not voted within the past five years.

The office is to call Niners to get a price on twenty covers for the voting machines.

The office has collected \$ 2,823.74 from filing fees and money received from the sale of voters list. A check for this amount will be turned over to the County Commissioners.

The voting machines at Dargan school, Old Wilson school and the Pythian Hall in Keedysville will be returned to the County Raods Department.

The voting conditions at the Old Wilson school were discussed. Mr. Long made a motion we use the Conococheague school for voting in future elections, instead of the Old Wilson school. Mr. Patterson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

We are to send tranfers to Kenneth & Mary Plank to correct their voting district.

Mrs. Waters told the Board Mr. Arthur Haines had several complaints from the people living at the Fahrney-Keedy Home who voted at the Mt. Lena school, about the many steps to get into the building. Mr. McCauley told us there is a side or rear entrance with only one step to enter the building. Mrs. Waters will call Mr. Haines.

It was called to the attention of the Board some people living on the Wagaman Road are in the wrong voting district. Mr. McCauley will check on this matter and have a report at the next meeting.

Mr. Long suggested we send Gov. Mandel a get-well card. Mrs. Phillips will purchase the card and the members will sign it.
