Meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on April 15th at 12 noon in the new Court House Annex.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read, and were approved as read.

Meeting was called by the President to discuss budget for the next fiscal year. Mr. Ralph McCauley, new member as of June 1st, was invited to attend.

Board suggested that we should examine number of poll workers needed at each voting district and investigate if there is any law requiring certain amount of workers for each machine.

Discussed getting bids on cost of transporting voting machines from Storage place to voting districts.

Board requested prices on 6 Additional Binders, 4" size.

Check for a more satisfactory place for voting in District 22-3 at present the Club House at Fairground.

Discussed voting rights of Mrs. Musselman, who had been a registered voter in Sharpsburg and is now residing in D.C. Mr. Harclerode requested letter be sent her quoting the law covering her case.

Analyze situation at polling place at closing of the polls to determine number of voting machines needed. Will discuss this later with the Chief Judges.

Discussed the splitting of Books in Dist # 5- 18-1 and 25-3, Board included cost pertaining to same in budget.
