

January 27, 1966.

The January meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on Thursday, January 27, at 5 P.M. in their office in the Court House Annex.

The following Members were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Under old business, Board discussed new forms. Mr. McCauley made motion that the following information be listed on I.B.M. cards to comply with the present Law;

Name, address, Color, Age at date of registration and year registered and that the I.B.M. Machine be so wired to print out the current age as the years progress. Seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Motion passed un-animously. Feb. 1, 1966 the new forms will be put in use.

The Board decided to continue the use of the old Transfer forms to be given to the political workers.

Voting Machine contract for 1-"Printomatic" Automatic Voting Machine for \$1715.00 was received and will be sent to County Commissioners for signatures.

Electrical receptacles needed at Voting Machine storage room, at Roads Dept. Mr. McCauley will discuss matter with Mr. Crossley, and report to the Board.

Mr. McCauley made motion that order for new Voting Machine Covers be tabled at this time. Motion seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Passed.

Board decided to have our Attorney, Mr. Dunham contact Mr. G. Merlin Snyder, Clerks Office regarding Sec. 43-C, names changed by marriage. And such list to be furnished from Jan. 1st, 1966.

Mr. Kaylor made motion to reinstate Mr. Walter D. DeLauder to our voters file, he was taken off thru error. Seconded by Mr. McCauley. Passed. Letter will be sent him notifying him of the Boards decision.

Our Attorney and Board discussed the "Corrupt Practice Act" that was put into Law June 1965. The Secretary of State will furnish us with summaries of the Corrupt Practice Act to be distributed to the individual Candidates when Filing, along with the 2 Forms outlined in the Act.

Mr. Kaylor made motion that the 2 Candidates who had previously Filed be advised by letter that they are required to appoint a Treasurer within 7 days of Receipt of this Letter, by advising Clerk of Court by letter of their respective Treasurers. Seconded by Mr. McCauley. Passed.

Board and Attorney discussed qualifications of Candidates and they will be carefully checked when Certificate is Filed.

Mr. Kaylor made motion to adjourn meeting, seconded by Mr. McCauley.
