

August 14, 1973

The Board of Election Supervisors met at the Court House on Tuesday, August 14, 1973 at 2:00 P.M.

The following members were present:

The voting machine contract has been signed and the two voting machines have been ordered.

Mr. Patterson read a letter from the Longmeadow Fire Co. allowing us to use the Fire Hall for voting. Mr. Long made a motion we donate \$25.00 for the use of the Fire Hall. Mr. Spigler seconded this motion. Motion carried.

The office received a letter from the County Comm. approving the budget as submitted, with one exception. The final allowance for travel was established at \$ 1,500.00. (We ask for \$ 2,000.00.)

Mr. Poole has prepared the resolution and the letters for the sub-dividing of district 27. The office is working on the sub-dividing.

The district will be divided with the Longmeadow Road and the Western Maryland Railroad as the dividing line between the two precincts. The area which lies to the south of Longmeadow Road and west of the Western Maryland Railroad will be known as district 27-1. The area which lies north of Longmeadow Road or east of the Western Maryland Railroad will be known as district 27-2.

The custodians have started to repair the voting machines. Mr. Spigler made a motion we repair and clean the covers that are in need of it. Mr. Long seconded the motion.

The Board decided to go to the Two Guys Dept. store and the Longmeadow Shopping Center for voter registration on Friday, August 24, 1973, from 7:00 to 9:00 P.M.

Further plans for Ocean City in Sept. was discussed.

Next meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 9, 1973.

Mr. Spigler made a motion for the meeting to adjourn. Mr. Long seconded the motion.
