

Oct. 3, 1967

The September meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was postponed until Oct. 3, at which time the meeting was held in the office at 3:30 P.M.

The minutes were read and approved.

Under old business, Mr. McCauley informed the Board that we could use the Grange Hall at Leitersburg for voting, if necessary, but no price has been determined for the rent of the Hall.

Also the transferring of the Pinesburg residents from Dist. 2 to Dist. 23 was discussed. After the names of those that need to be transferred are secured, The Board will write up a letter to go along with the transfers when they are sent out.

Our Attorney discussed the removal of voters for not voting in 5 years. The Attorney ruled that City Elections cannot be used as being an election, when determining those to be removed for not voting in 5 calendar years. He suggested we keep out the registration cards of those who have voted in a City Election but not in a State or National Election in the past 5 years and take this matter up with the City to see what they want to do about this.

Discussed changing the forms of registration as set up in the new law. Motion by Mr. Kaylor and seconded by Mr. Long that we use the present forms until the supply is used up. Motion carried unanimously.

After much discussion a motion by Mr. Long and seconded by Mr. McCauley that we charge 50¢ for all voters certificates, as of this date. Motion carried unanimously. A record of all money received and disbursed will be kept.

The minutes and discussions of the recent Association meeting at Bowie were presented. It was noted that there are many changes in the new election laws. Further study of these changes will be presented at future Board meetings.

Motion made to adjourn. Carried.
