Franklin St., to be used as voting space and he contacted Mr. Fred Noland, and he agreed to let us have the space for \$30.00 and letter will be sent him to verify the agreement.

Board said to advertise Night Openings for August 18 & 20th at our office for extra voter registration.

Mr. Zombro was requested to have sign printed as follows "Washington County Voter Registration", for Booth at Hagerstown Fair.

Board agreed to have Junior Waters purchase material and install Booth at Fairground, and present bill for same.

Ask Mr. Colton to check into Home Rule Petitions and advise us the last Day they can be received by us and he should notify public thru the press of his decision. Also if there is any ruling on how an Election District box can be split into 2 books and have 1 set of poll workers operate 2 books at same salary?

Board decided that Office Clerks would handle Soldier Absentee Ballots and Civilian Absentee Ballots without the approval of the Board unless they felt there was any questionable applications to notify Board for final disposition of same.

Mr. Harclerode made motion to adjourn meeting and it was seconded by Mr. Zombro.
