

July 8, 1964

The monthly meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on July 7th, at 3:30 P.M. at their office in the New Court House Annex.

The following Members of the Board were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Mr. Harclerode advised that the Democrats are making plans for a large registration drive and information concerning same will be discussed later. Mr. Irwin Hoffman is Chairman of this project and they suggest that this office be open 5 nights a week and also go to County Towns to register new voters.

Letter was received from Mr. Charles Hoffman, of Hoffman Chev. Company stating that their place would not be available for voting anymore and Board discussed same and decided each would check for available place for voting in District 22-1 and report at next meeting.

Mrs. Hann thanked Board by way of letter to Mr. Harclerode, thanking him for kindness shown her when she worked in here, during Mary Stahl's absence.

Board was informed that we had received \$1,042.86 from Fileing fees and sale of Voters Lists to Candidates which was returned by check to Board of County Commissioners.

Mr. Zombro made motion that Mr. Richard C. Smith, chewsville be appointed Substitute Democrat Machine Custodian, to replace Mr. Jessup, and a letter be sent to Mr. Smith advising him of the appointment. Also a letter be sent to Mr. Jessop advising him of his release due to his present position which would not permit him to be available when needed, seconded by Mr. Harclerode. Motion carried.

Discussed letter received from Maryland Assoc. of Election Officials, advising us of next planned meeting to be held in Easton, Md., on Oct. 7-8. This was tabled until later meeting.
