Dottie reported on the MAEO meeting that was held at Hunt Valley on Jan. 17 and 18.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Mr. Bast distributed to the Board members copies of the letter from Bob Antonetti, newly elected President of the Maryland Association of Election Officials and a list of his various committees which will be effective for 1982.

The Board discussed Senate Bill #289 that was received from Senator Cushwa.

Mr. Bast read a memo from Barry Teach, County Administrator, regarding a training session on interviewing techniques that will be held on February 24th from 2 to 4 P. M. Dottie and Daris will attend.

Under old business Dottie advised the Board that it was necessary to request a line item change in the budget of \$700 from Material and Supplies to Automobile Allowance. The request for this change has been granted.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board discussed the schooling for the Distributors of Voter Registration Application Forms. The Board decided to hold the school on Tuesday, March 23 and Wednesday, March 31 at 7:30 P.M. in the Conference room in the County Office Building. This will be advertised and anyone who has been trained and has not been actively involved in voter registration since January 1, 1981, will need to be retrained.

The Board discussed the voter registration drive that the Tavern Association is conducting. We will train their distributors on Wednesday, Feb. 17 and 24 at 10 A. M.

The pamphlet concerning absentee voting for those persons in the hospitals was presented. The Board decided to use these and we will contact the Washington County Hospital to see if they are interested in distributing these.

Dottie advised the Board that 3,800 letters had been sent to those persons not voting in the past five years and that approximately 1,200 had come back.

Motion by Virgil Banzhoff and seconded by Charles Downey that we hire Nancy Kauffman as our extra part-time Democrat girl. Motion carried.

Motion by Charles Downey and seconded by Virgil Banzhoff that the meeting be adjourned at 3:00 P. M. Motion carried. The next regular meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 9, at 2:00 P. M. Notice of this meeting will be properly posted.
