Kemp Is Named Board Attorney

**Election Supervisors
Swear In, Organize And
Make Appointments.**

Attorney T. Aubrey Kemp is the new attorney to the Board of Election Supervisors, succeeding the late Calvert K. Hartle.

Mr. Kemp was appointed by the Board early this afternoon on recommendation of the Democratic Central Committee. He retired as City Councilman from Ward 5 on April 1.

Mrs. Virginia S. Clopper was re-named the Democratic Permanent Register and Clerk to the Board and was sworn in at once.

Mrs. Alsetta U. Myers was reappointed the Republican Permanent Register some weeks ago by Governor Wm. Preston Lane, Jr., and qualified by swearing in before the Clerk of Court.

J. Richard Rauth, William McP Miller and William T. Snyder, who make up the Board of Supervisors, swore in at noon for their new two-year terms and organized by electing Mr. Rauth to succeed himself as president. Mr. Snyder, the Republican member, was elected secretary.
