A regular meeting was held by the Board of Election Supervisors at the office at 103 S. Potomac St., Sept. 4, 1962 at 10 AM.

The following members of the Board were present:

They discussed the setting up of the Ballot and Mr. Hellane suggested spaces between the County Offices be used, But Mr. McCauley and Mr. Stouffer thought that would be showing partiality toward the County Candidates, and they went on record as favoring a Bold line to divide the different offices including the State Offices and County Offices, as we lacked enough spaces to include the entire ticket.

The Board agreed to leave the voting place for Boonsboro, Dist.6 at the Junior High School for the General Election, also to use Pangborn Elementary School for Dist 18-2 in place of the Old White Oak Forrest School, they will make a decision on Dist.15 - Indian Springs in the near future.

They agreed to sell a used Binder to the Town of Sharpsburg, for holding their voters registration record for the sum of \$10.00.

The Democrat members of the Board gave instruction that cards be sent to poll workers at once. They changed Charles W Boyer to Ch. Judge, and Cynthia Smith to Judge and C. Clagett Spielman to Guard in Dist 25-1 also to reinstate Mayme M. Bloom as Judge in Dist. 25-2.

The Board decided to hold a school in October to give instructions to all Poll Workers.

An order for Voting Certificates Cards and Absentee Ballots were given to Rudy & Spong. The Hag. Bkbg. & Prtg. will bid on other Election Supplies.
