New residency law for Maryland has been passed, but can't be publicized until the Governor signs the resolution.

As soon as the candidates file their final treasurer's report, we are to inform the State Office immediately.

The letter to the poll workers at Antietam Professional Center to be drafted in the rough for the Board's approval at the next meeting.

Start pulling five-year non-voters and send cards next week.

It was suggested that we mark the file copy for voting and type new file cards (forms ran out) that have already registered at the same time we type the new 30-yr. forms in order to save time.
