Meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on ~~Tues-~~ Monday June 13, at 5 PM in the Court House Annex.

The following Members were present:

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Under old business reported that Machine Custodians were still installing new cords and had completed 77 Machines.

Regarding new Voting Machine , Mr. McCauley made motion that we purchase new voting Machine at once for the Primary, seconded by Mr. Kaylor, motion carried.

New Absentee Registration Forms was discussed and motion made to run off New Forms on Zerox Machine. Also order 50 envelopes for mailing same & Rubber Stamp for office.

Mr. McCauley made motion to pay Mrs. Hann \$1.45 per hour for Registration Work, seconded by Mr. Harclerode. Mr. Kaylor abstained from voting. Mr. McCauley went before the Board on June 14th and was refused the raise.

Mr. McCauley made motion to pay Maryland Association dues, seconded by Mr. Harclerode, Motion carried.

Mr. Dunham , our Attorney reported on New Districting law, which reduces number of Delegates to House, to Four and Delegates to State Convention & Central Committee Member to 5 each. Also reported that Declined Voters will be allowed to vote in the combined Special & Primary Election due to Referendum being on the ballot, and they can only vote for that particular question.

Board set the withdrawal date of Candidates to be July 30 at noon.

Discussed school for Poll Workers and same was tabled until later meeting. We will have approximately 25 new Chief Judges.

Mr. Dunham gave an opinion to the Board stating that no one may use a nickname to file as a Candidate, that christian names must be used.

Registration at Fairground was tabled until a later date.
