A meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on Oct. 28th, at 1 PM in the Court House Annex: The following Members were present.

The Board met and approved the Specimen Ballot that must be put in the papers on Saturday Oct. 29th.

Mr. Harclerode had another appointment and Mr. Donald Zombro acted as Vice-Chairman of the meeting.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Under old business bill of Mr. Willie Dunham, Boards attorney, was tabled until full Board could pass on same.

Mr. Woodrow Rippeon, Dem. Board Member substitute acted after Mr. R. A. McCauley resigned as of Oct. 8th.

Mr. Donald E Zombro, was appointed by the Governor and swore in on Oct. 24th., as Democrat Permanent Board Member to fill out the unexpired term of Mr. Ralph A McCauley.

Board ruled that if List are still available without printing same they still can be sold upon requests.

Mr. Zombro made motion that we hire Marie Russell for the switchboard on Election Day as the Court House will be closed. We will have her from 8 AM till 5 PM. Seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Motion passed unamously.

Letter from Mr. Kepler of the Board of Education was presented to the Board as to the locations of the voting Machines in the different school. Mr. Kaylor will check on the location at Woodland Way School. Others seem satisfactory.

Board requested that letters be sent to both Central Committees stating the Board has ruled that as the Primary Election was held at The Army Reserve Center that the General Election should be held at same location. Mr. Zombro made motion and it was seconded by Mr. Kaylor. Passed unamously.

Board reviewed applications from several absentee voters and letters will be sent advising them of the Board decision.
