

A meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on March 30th, at 5 Pm in the Court House Annex;

The following members were present:

The minutes of the ~~meeting~~ previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

Under old business letter was sent to Mrs. Smith, Boonsboro, Md quoting her the law pertaining to registering to vote in this County

Under other old business was bill for extra fee for Attorney Dunham on canvass day, Zombro made motion to send him a check for \$100. Motion passed unanimously. Send letter explaining reason for reducing the amount of payment was that the Board had raised his compensation on Mar. 23, 1966 to \$50 to take care of additional legal advice.

Board authorized additional phones installed for Election Day.

Board decided to leave the Voting District 22-3 at the Army Reserve Center on Willard St, for this Special Election.

Board requested that we give new law to Mr. Dwyer and request him to give us Dates and Data covering the Special Election on June 13, 1967

Have notice given to paper each week stating additional hours office will be open for persons to file for Delegates to the Constitutional Convention.

Letter to Chief Judges was presented to Board and was accepted.

Mr. Kaylor made motion to let Clearspring High School have the use of 2 large voting machines for their use with out charge providing they would pay all expenses covering the moving from the Roads Department to the school and the cost of setting up of the machines by the Machine Custddians. Seconded by Mr. Zombro, pased unanimously.

Mr. Zombro made motion that same guards be used for the Special Election on June 13th, as had been sworn in and used in 1966 Elections. Motion passed.

Certificate of Candidacy prepared by the Board for use in the Special Election for Delegates to the Constitutional Convention was approved.

Mr. Zombro moved that Mr. Dwyer be appointed as Attorney to Board to fill out the balance of this term. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Kaylor made motion to adjourn meeting. seconded by Mr. Zombro.

Meeting adjourned.
