

September 10, 1963.

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Election Supervisors was held on Sept. 10, at the New Court House Annex at 3 P.M.

The following members of the Board were present:

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and were approved as read.

I presented Bills for the Month of August for Machine Custodians & the marking off of new maps for Counter, which were approved and sent to County Commissioners for payment.

I presented Binder that was suggested to be purchased by Board to include news items relating to our office.

Under old business, we never heard from Mr. Ridenour, so I asked Mr. Jessop, a former employee to be here at 3:30 P.M. to meet with the board and discuss his replacing Mr. Ridenour as Asst. Democrat Custodian. Mr. Dorsey said that they work 2 days each week at Huyetts and will take him along if he is accepted for a refresher course.

Mr. Jessop appeared before Board & was interviewed by them. Mr. Zombro made a motion to accept Mr. Jessop as our Asst. Democrat Custodian, and Mr. Bikle seconded same, motion was passed unanimously. He will contact our regular Custodians about dates for a refresher course & submit his bill to this office for payment.

Mr. Colton, our attorney, appeared before Board at their request to enlighten us regarding Registration & swearing off of voters.

Mr. Zombro made motion that this Board enforce the provisions of Section 1- Article 1- of the Constitution of Maryland, regarding qualifications & Registration of Voters. Motion was passed unanimously.

Mr. Colton suggested that we make up special stamped card & send to voters notifying them of the change of address only.

Also Transfer's mailed to voters & not returned to us should be included on "Special List" for Revision Day as stated in Article # 31, pertaining to Disqualified Voters & Removed Voters.

I informed Board Members if they desired to be included in Retirement or Hospital Coverage to appear before Clerk in Co. Commissioners Office and sign forms.

I reported to the Board about the conditions of covers for Machines, and they agreed if new covers were needed for Machines now stored in Public places they should be provided but felt if old ones at Huyetts were not torn and would act as dust covers not to change them at this time.

There being no further business at this time, meeting was adjourned.
