

Nov. 15, 1967

The Board of Election Supervisors held its regular monthly meeting at the office on Nov. 15, 1967 at 3:30 P.M.

The Board met with Mr. Wakenight, representative from Long's Business Equipment, to discuss the types and prices of Conference tables and chairs.

After much discussion a motion was made by Mr. Long and seconded by Mr. McCauley that we request two tables 34" x 60" and one table 36" x 24" and 6 chairs. Motion carried. Mr. Wakenight will present this request to Mr. Parsley.

The minutes were read and approved.

Under old business it was reported that we sent 36 transfers to Pinesburg residents and that 15 have been returned. We will wait until the next meeting to see if we get the remaining ones back in.

Discussed the people that we are taking off for not voting in five years. There are 2,178 to come off. 200 of these are persons that voted either in the 1963 or 1965 City Elections. The Board decided to hold out these 200 cards and invite the City's Attorney, Mr. Boublitz, to a future meeting, to determine what should be done about these people.

According to the new law, a map showing the boundaries of all election districts and precincts within the County must be filed with the Secretary of State by Jan. 1, 1968. We have written to John Hopkins University to get the price of a map that we can use for this purpose.

We advised the Board of the Courthouse Christmas Party to be held on Dec. 15 at 6:30 P.M. at the Delmar Inn.

Board decided to have the next meeting on Monday, Dec. 11th, with a Christmas Party following the meeting.

Motion that meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
