Bills for the School Custodians, working overtime at Schools where we are conducting night registration were presented to Board, and same was approved for payment.

Discussed Home Rule Petitions and Mr. Harclerode will call personally to Mr. Sweeney, Asst. Atty. General, and advise us on his decision regarding same being on the Absentee Ballots.

Several Absentee Ballot Applications were screened by the Board Members, and those not meeting with the requirement set by law, will be advised that they will not be eligible for an Absentee Ballot from our County.

Certifications of nominations filed with the Secretary of State was received by our Office and were turned over to our printer, and proof of Absentee Ballots will be given us in a few days.
